

NOTICE OF DEFERRED ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

45th ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING | TUESDAY, 15 DECEMBER 2020, 5.00PM

The South Australian Jockey Club (SAJC) refers to its Notice of Annual General Meeting dated 29 October 2020 (the "**Original Notice**") for the Annual General Meeting originally scheduled for 25 November 2020. The Annual General Meeting was deferred pursuant to the SAJC's announcement to members dated 18 November 2020.

The deferral was made in accordance with the Consumer Business Services directive as set out in regulation 6(1) of the COVID-19 Emergency Response (Section 14) Regulations 2020 (SA) (currently in force and dated 30 July 2020) which states: "In accordance with section 14 of the [COVID-19 Emergency Response] Act [2020 (SA)], the period within which a prescribed association must hold an annual general meeting in accordance with section 39 of the Associations Incorporation Act 1985 is extended by 6 months."

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the deferred 45th Annual General Meeting (the "**AGM**") of the SAJC will be convened and held at Morphettville Racecourse on **Tuesday, 15 December 2020 at 5.00pm** immediately following the Norwood Community Club Annual General Meeting.

All votes at a general meeting of Members must be cast personally by a Member. Only Corporate Members are entitled to appoint a proxy to attend and, on their behalf, vote at a general meeting of Members. Notice of the appointment of proxy by a Corporate Member must be given to the Chief Executive Officer at least 24 hours before the time of the meeting.

To enable the SAJC to verify each Voting Member's entitlement to vote or take part in the meeting, all moneys due and payable by the Member to the Club must be paid prior to the meeting. All Members are asked to bring photo ID to enable them to be marked-off the register upon entry.

In addition, the revised closing date for the receipt of properly completed ballot papers for election to the SAJC Board is 4.00pm on Monday, 14 December 2020.
